A reading challenge for all ages! Complete the Bingo and Reading challenges and get entered into a fun prize drawing!

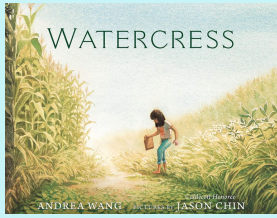

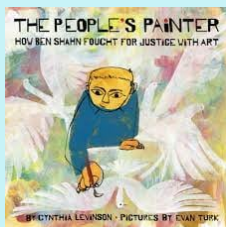
