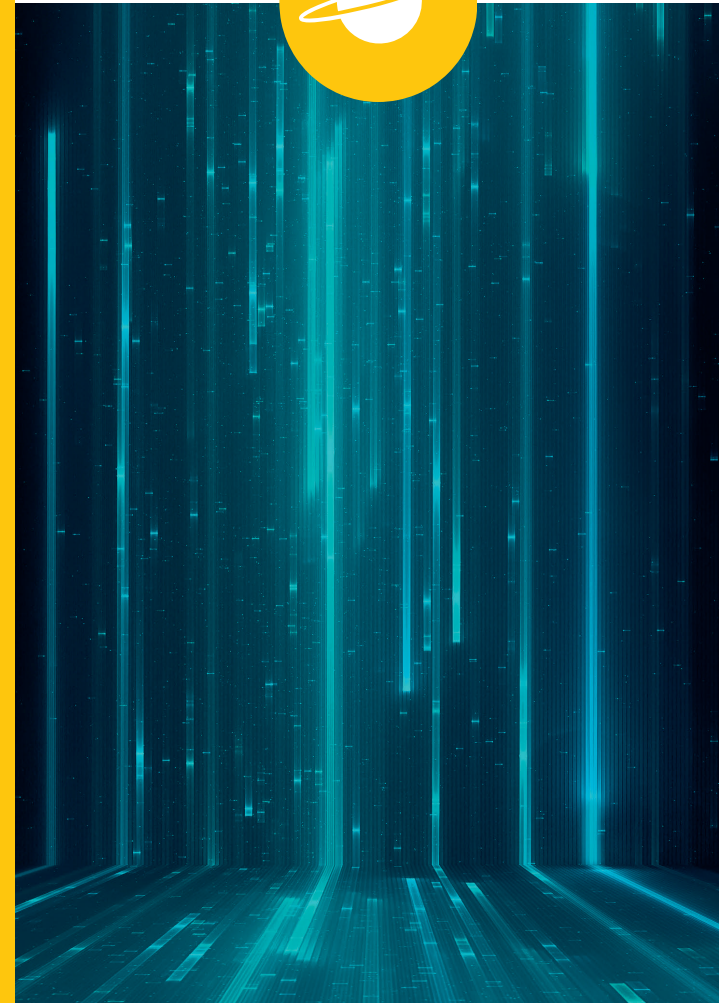

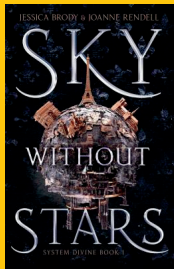

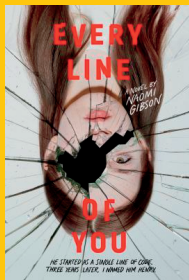


Sky Without Stars

The Last 8

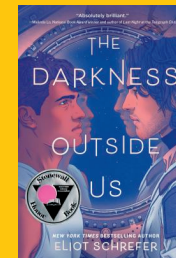
Laura Pohl (T POHL, L)
