Clown in a Cornfield

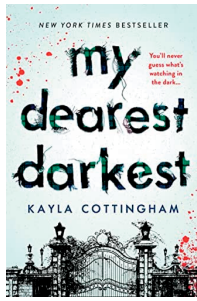

My Dearest Darkest

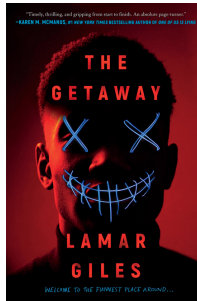

The Honeys

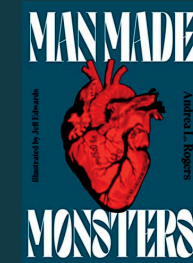
Ryan La Sala (T LA SALA, R)

Alongside the pedestrian oppressiveness of this summer camp is something more alarming: memories vanish, as do people. With only one ally among the boys, Mars is drawn to the girls who tend the camp's beehives. But the girls (and bees) are as sinister as they are welcoming.

The Mary Shelley Club
