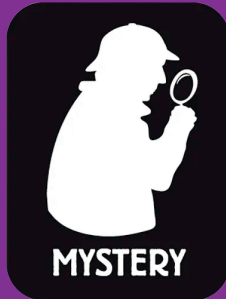

The Naturals

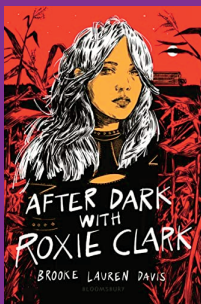
Jennifer Barnes (T BARNES, J)

We Deserve Monuments

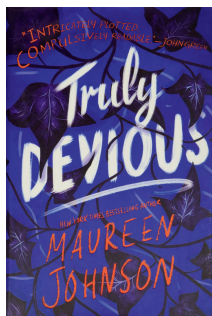
Jas Hammonds (T HAMMONDS, J)

Before I Let Go

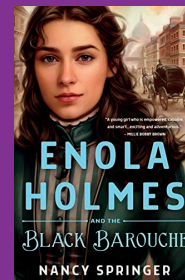
Marieke Nijkamp (T NIJKAMP, M)
