4. Business:

a) Sidewalk Infill & Prioritization

The Board was given a list of potential sidewalk infill projects. The Board would like to know how projects are given a rating of importance by staff. Members of the Board suggested the use a strategy of starting with low priority projects to evaluate. Another member suggested looking into asphalt paths, which have lower initial cost, but more upkeep cost down the line. Resident Vince Miles posed questions regarding project P55 on the list of potential sidewalk infill projects. Currently there are no funds dedicated to sidewalk infill jobs. Previous projects were funded by GO bond funds when in conjunction with other projects. Staff will ask our consultant Kittelson, how these projects are prioritized. What criteria is used, what has changed since the 2016 report. The discussion will resume during the next meeting on 6/26/2024.

5. General Capital Project Update

Staff shared they are continuing to work on design for Cedar Oak. Work is ongoing and ramping up at Fields Bridge Park. Trees will be planted along the Salamo Road project. The 10th street roundabout will require some redo work.
